Rules & Regulations

- **School Only entry forms and exhibits must be completed and returned to the Entry Secretary 1 week prior to show day. Entries can be delivered to the Hall of Industry at the Bream Creek Showground between 9am and 5pm on Monday 16th March.**
- All items must be completed at school and must be student's own work.
- One entry per student each class.
- Cookery items to be on white disposable plates. Labels must be attached to the plate, not plastic cover
- Photographs must be taken by exhibitor and mounted on black A5 cardboard (148mm x 210mm).
- Maximum exhibit size A3.
- All other rules as for adults.
- Students will not be entered individually, but will be entered under the teacher's name.
- Students name and school must be clearly shown on the bottom right hand corner of the back of each exhibit.
- Entry labels will be posted to the teacher & must be attached to the front of each exhibit before delivery.
- Failure to adhere to these rules will mean the entry will not be judged
- All exhibits must be entered, delivered and collected by an authorised school representative.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd certificates and prize money will be awarded in each class.

NOTE: COLLECTION OF WORK AFTER 4PM on SHOWDAY

- Children cannot collect their own work, prize certificate or prize money.
- All school entries, prize certificates and prize money must be collected by the teacher, or an authorised school representative.
- No responsibility will be accepted for work not collected by 5pm on show day, but any prize money not collected will be sent to the school the week following the show.
