## Giant Pumpkin and Vegetable Competition Entries:

- Entries can be delivered to the show ground between 9:00am to 6:00pm on Friday 20th or between 7:00am to 9:00am on show day. They must be in position on the arena by 9am when vehicle access is no longer permitted.

## Delivery of exhibits:

- Entries for all other outside competitions will be accepted on show day.
- Exhibitors needing vehicle access to the showground on show day to deliver exhibits must have a pre-purchased ticket and use Gate 2 (previously the Exhibitors Gate).

## On the day:

- All exhibitors must purchase a ticket for entry to the show grounds, ie: (there is no free entry).

## Collection of exhibits and prizes:

- Exhibits can be collected after 4 pm.
- Prizes, certificates and prize money can be collected from the Secretary's Office after the event.
- The committee cannot accept any responsibility for exhibits or prize money not collected by 5.00 pm on show day.

# AGRICULTURAL COMPETITIONS

## Wool

All fleeces must be grown by the exhibitor.

All entries must be skirted ewe or wether fleeces.

All fleeces must be in wool packs – no plastic bags accepted.

Fleeces must be from commercially run flocks and must not be shedded or rugged.

Fleeces must be delivered by 18th March, 2020 to Roberts Wool store, Brighton.

Sashes for Grand Champion Fleece and Most Commercially Valuable Fleece and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> for each class.

Pasture judged during 2nd week of March 2020. Results displayed in the Wool Pavilion on show day.

Minimum pasture size 2ha, sown prior to autumn 2019 and within 50km of Bream Creek.

To enable fairer assessment of entries, entrants need to provide basic information for each entry with basic sowing, fertiliser and grazing history.

Prize money: 1st: \$100.00, 2nd: \$50.00, 3rd: \$25.00
