Vehicles must then be parked in the Exhibitors carpark and cannot leave that carpark until after 4pm on Showday.

All fleeces must be in wool packs – no plastic bags accepted.

Fleeces must be from commercially run flocks and must not be shedded or rugged.

Fleeces must be delivered to the Wool Pavilion no later than midday on Friday the 17th March.
