



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Acceptance & Refusal of Entries/Exhibits

Entries and exhibits will be received subject to these Terms and Conditions

- 1.1. The Chief Steward, after consultation with Stewards or Committee members, may remove or refuse admission to the Show any exhibit suspected of being dangerous or objectionable.
- 1.2. The Owner of an entry subject to 1.1 must immediately remove their exhibit. Any exhibit removed or refused will be deemed ineligible and will not be judged.
- 1.3. Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy and eligibility to exhibit in a Section or Class specified in the Schedule.
- 1.4. Only one entry per class can be submitted for Photography, Juniors, and Schools.
- 1.5. Two entries may be submitted in all other classes.
- 1.6. Entrants in the Junior Section may only enter their own age group.
- 1.7. Deadlines for entries and exhibits as they appear in the Schedule must be adhered to.
- 1.8. Late entries and exhibits will not be accepted, except when dates are extended by the Committee or approved by Chief Steward.

2. Integrity of Exhibits

- 2.1. Every Exhibitor must agree their exhibits have either been solely created, grown, or produced by them, and must be their own genuine property.
- 2.2. Junior exhibits must be genuinely and solely created, grown, or produced by the Junior Exhibitor except where assistance is reasonably required for their safety and only to the extent that is applicable to their age and capability.
- 2.3. Exhibits entered at a previous Bream Creek Show may not be entered again.
- 2.4. Collaborative works to be entered in the name of the creative entity. e.g., Smith family, Dunalley Primary School etc.

3. Arrangement & Moving Exhibits

- 3.1. Arrangement of exhibits in sections and classes is to be conducted only by stewards.

4. Removal of Entries and Exhibits

- 4.1. Exhibits can only be removed from display during the times advertised in the Schedule.
- 4.2. Exhibitors or their agent must present their duplicate exhibit cards as proof of ownership when collecting exhibits after display.

5. Judging of Awards

- 5.1. Only Stewards assisting Judges or Officials approved by the Chief Steward are permitted to be in the exhibition area during judging.
- 5.2. The Judge's decision is final.
- 5.3. Exhibits shall not display any identifying mark, or name while being judged.
- 5.4. Judges can withhold awarding a prize if exhibits:
 - a. are of an inferior quality.
 - b. are not suitable for the Section and Class.
- 5.5. Judges can award a second or third prize, instead of awarding a first prize.
- 5.6. An exhibit may be disqualified by a Judge if it does not comply with the section rules.
- 5.7. Only one prize card will be issued for each prize won.

6. Prize Money

- 6.1. Prizemoney will be paid in cash on the day of the Show.

6.2. Prizemoney not collected by 5pm on Showday will be forfeited to the Society by the Exhibitor.

7. Protests

7.1. All protests must be:

- a. made in writing to the Show Secretary, detailing the reason for the protest
- b. lodged by 12pm on Showday and accompanied with a \$20 fee

7.2. The Chief Steward shall adjudicate the protest in such a manner as they see fit, having regard to the interests of the protestor, and all exhibitors.

7.3. Where the Chief Steward deems a protest to be unfounded or frivolous the fee shall be forfeited and paid into the funds of the Society.

7.4. If a protest is upheld, the exhibitor and exhibits will be disqualified, and prize money forfeited.

7.5. If a protest is upheld the Chief Steward will determine if class/es will be rejudged.

7.6. All relevant parties will be informed of the outcome.

8. Disqualification and Forfeiture of Prizemoney

8.1. The Chief Steward may disqualify any Exhibitor from exhibiting at the Bream Creek Show for such a period as it sees fit where:

- a. There has been a breach of the Terms and Conditions.
- b. The conduct of an Exhibitor is unfit to exhibit at the Show.

9. Liability of Society

9.1. All reasonable care will be taken to protect the property of the Exhibitor.

9.2. The Society will not be responsible for any damage or loss incurred by an Exhibitor.

9.3. The Society will not be liable for any damage to any Exhibits, and it is a condition of entry that each Exhibitor will hold the Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings.

10. Recording of Images of Attendees

Attendees at the event or in the car parks acknowledge that the BCSS Inc and third parties authorised by the BCSS may make, record, transmit, reproduce or use recordings and images or any of them of, at or in relation to the event (including, without limitation, of attendees).

Unless the attendee otherwise reaches an agreement with the BCSS Inc to the contrary, the attendee consents to the taking of photographs, film, tapes and other images for the use on our website, and/or in any media (including publications within and outside Tasmania, Australia) and for any purpose, without identification or compensation or payment of any kind.

11. Privacy Act Statement

The information provided by the Exhibitor on the Entry form or Showday Online is collected and used by BCSS to organise and conduct competitions at the Show. We may publish details such as your name and exhibit details in any BCSS publication or communication. Such information may also be made available to, and published by, the media. We will not disclose your information without your consent for any other purpose unless required or authorised by law. You may request access to your personal information and, if necessary, request that our records of that information be corrected by writing to the President at the Bream Creek Show Society Inc, PO Box 133, Dunalley, Tas 7177.

12. Definitions

- CHIEF STEWARD – A person appointed by the Society's Committee of Management to manage the schedule and stewards and judges in the Hall of Industries.
- HALL OF INDUSTRY SUB- COMMITTEE – Volunteers for the committee that support the Chief Steward and Entry Secretary in the execution of their tasks. .
- ENTRY – The information submitted that describes what you intend to exhibit at the Show.
- ENTRY SECRETARY – A person appointed by the Society's Committee of Management to manage the entries on behalf of the exhibitors.
- EXHIBIT – The article that you submit to be exhibited and judged at the Bream Creek Show.
- EXHIBITOR – Person entering exhibits in the exhibition.
- SCHEDULE – The collection of information produced by the Society which describes the requirements for entries and exhibits at the Show.
- SHOW – The Bream Creek Show.

- SHOWGROUNDS – Bream Creek Showgrounds; the premises of the Society located at 138 Marion Bay Road, Bream Creek.
- STEWARD – A person appointed by the Chief Steward to supervise a section or sections of the Exhibition during the running of the Show.
- THE SOCIETY – Bream Creek Show Society Incorporated (BCSS).
