- Exhibits can be collected after 4 pm.
- The committee cannot accept any responsibility for exhibits or prize money not collected by 5.00 pm on show day.

Heaviest Pumpkin and Giant Vegetable Competition Entries:

- Entries can be delivered between 9:00am and 6:00pm on Friday 14th or between 7:00am and 9:00am on Showday. Entries must be in position on the arena by 9.00am. Vehicles must then be parked in the Exhibitors carpark and cannot leave that carpark until after 4pm on Showday.

All fleeces must be grown by the exhibitor.

All entries must be skirted ewe or wether fleeces.

All fleeces must be in wool packs – no plastic bags accepted.

Fleeces must be from commercially run flocks and must not be shedded or rugged.

Fleeces must be delivered to the Wool Pavilion no later than midday on Friday the 14th March.
